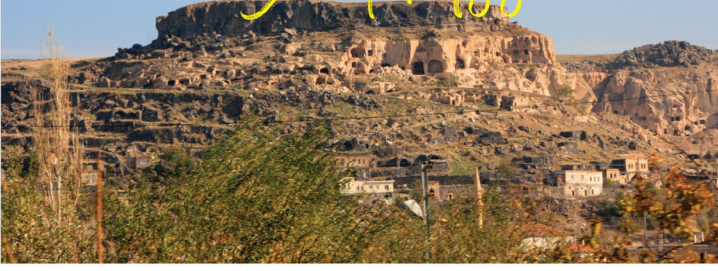

The village of Mazi, whose ancient name is "Mataza", is 18 kilometres south of Ürgüp and 10 kilometres east of the underground city of Kaymakli. There are four entrances in different locations in order to enter the underground city, and main entrance is a short corridor made of irregular stones. The large sliding stone in the short corridor provides control of the entrance and exit of the Underground City. The small room in the interior was made for easy movement of the sliding stone.



The abundance of barns spread over large areas of underground settlement is noteworthy. The Church of the Underground City is accessible via a short corridor from the barns. The entrance of this place can be closed with a sliding stone. The church apse is carved into the long edge corner, in contrast to the church in the underground city of Kaymakli, and decorated with facade reliefs.
