
From 9 billion-year the past to the present







The Museum of Muğla was opened to visitors in 1994 when the plant and animal fossils unearthed in the Özlüce in 1993 began to be exhibited. The museum, which was used as a prison building for a while after the Republican Period, consists of 5 sections with 4 closed exhibitions and 1 open exhibition area.

Natural History Section

Bones and plant fossils belonging to animal species that lived 9 to 5 million years ago in the Muğla region are exhibited in the first natural history hall of Muğla.

Ethnography Hall

Tools and equipment related to clothing, weaving and carpentry professions are used in the daily life from the Republican Era to the present day are exhibited.



Gladiator Hall

Funerary stelaes of gladiators, brutal and brave warriors of the past, await visitors.

Courtyard (Open Display)

The historical journey from the Classical Period to the Eastern Rome period continues here with our marble works.
