When the Great Leader Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk went to Samsun on 19 May 1919, he stayed in this building known as Mintika (Mantika) Palas. The building was later presented to the Great Leader by the people of Samsun on his second visit on September 20-24, 1924. Again, on 16 September 1928 and 22 November 1930, Atatürk stayed in this building when he visited Samsun. The museum welcomed visitors on 08 November 1998. Atatürk's civil and military belongings and wax sculptures representing Atatürk and his 18 arms friends are worth seeing.
