Guidi, who visited the city in 1920, considering the size of the building, said it could be a fish market (macellum). Located in the open-air museum and dated back to 2nd century A.D., the grave structure has a square plan (10 x 7 m.) and the remnants of the grave are exhibited in the middle part of the museum.



It was opened to visitors in 1955 as an open-air museum after having been restorated by the Turkish-Italian Cooperation. This building complex that located in Kıyıkışlacık District consists of a monumental tomb in the middle of a rectangular area with a podium with a prostylos plan and arched porticoes surrounding the area. Stone and terracotta artifacts found in and around Iasos Ancient City excavations are exhibited in the museum.
