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From Osman Hamdi Bey to the Present

The sanctuary, which has a 3000-year history, is also the first excavation site in the Ottoman period with a Turkish director. The excavations, which continued with Prof. Dr. Yusuf BOYSAL, Prof. Dr. Ahmet TIRPAN respectively, have been in progress under the directorate of Prof. Dr. Bilal SÖĞÜT as of 2018.



The Sanctuary of Each Period

Many buildings were built during the Classical, Hellenistic and Roman Imperial Periods in and around the Sanctuary of Lagina. The fact that here is the only large-scale temple known to have been built in 100 BC and the use of Corinthian order, which is the most expensive architectural order of antiquity, in this structure shows the importance of the temple. The support of the Roman Emperor Augustus and the fact that it was written on the lintel in Propylon reveals that the Sanctuary of Lagina has great importance and sanction power in the region.
