Natural History Museums being among the scientific and cultural symbols of developed countries, are contemporary educational institution that collect, archive and exhibit the knowledge of natural assets on a national and local scale, and also provide educational/social activities.



The Burdur basin and the formation at the base of it consist of lacustrine sediments. Swampy areas formed due to tectonic movements within the basin gradually turned into a lake. Elmacik Vertebrate Fossil Bed, located south of this lake, known as Burdur Pliocene Lake, is one of the most productive fossil beds of the Lakes Region.
