Atatürk House Museum







The two-storey museum was built in Silifke
District in 1914 using wood and stone materials.
The building was expropriated and restored by
the Ministry of Culture in 1982 and was opened
to service as Atatürk's House and Ethnography
Museum on January 2, 1987. Mustafa Kemal
ATATÜRK visited Silifke 4 times due to the
establishment of a cooperative and a farm, as well
as domestic trips.



A marble monument and statue was erected near Taşköprü in relation to Atatürk's first visits to Silifke, but this was not considered sufficient and necessary steps were taken to build a library and museum in the name of Mustafa Kemal ATATÜRK for the memory of the visit. All the furniture and articles, in the room of the house where Atatürk spent the night during his first visit to Silifke on January 27, 1925, which is a museum now, documents concerning the establishment of a cooperative, visit photographs, newspaper reports, and ethnographic items common to the region are on display.
