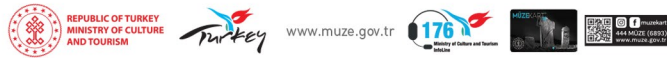

Stratonicea Where History and Archeology Meet

It is one of the rare places where Antique and Ottoman and Republican Period building and urban texture can be seen together. The fact that many buildings of different periods are intertwined is a unique opportunity for visitors to the city. All the buildings in the ancient city can be visited by walking on the stone paved roads of Ottoman Period.

In the time known as the "five good emperors" in the Roman Empire, he came to power after Hadrian and ruled peacefully. The nickname of Pius, which means "responsible, obedient" in Latin, was given by the senate because of his pioussness, lack of vindictiveness and dignity.



Eternal Resting Place of the Haughty Gladiators

Stratonicea Antique City, which has been inhabited since the Late Bronze Age, is named after Stratonicea, the wife of Seleucid King Antiochus I. It is also a resting place where Gladiators, who survive after many fights, live retirement life.
